We contacted our local EBP who arranged for us to work with a local high school.

A freelance artist educator was appointed to consult with teachers of GCSE Textiles, and develop the contents of the handling collection. The next step was to trial the collection with a group of pupils who visited the gallery.

Their experiences were evaluated and fed back into the finished boxes and the supporting notes.

Through handling original items, students were highly motivated to do their own research
